

Andrzej and Zofia Michalkiewicz farm

Zgnilobloty is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Bobrowo, within Brodnica County, Kuyavian-Pomeranian Voivodeship

Together with my wife Zofia we are holding 25 ha farm conducted in the organic way. The farm was converted in 1986, and the first certificate of the organic food production we have got in 1990. We decided to move the farm into organic production being directed by conscience and values.

We think that use of chemicals and interference in genetics is a kind of crime, because we maim humankind and nature. Destroying biological composition of soil that is the carrier of life we create a desert, leading to climate change.

We believe that agriculture from the time when use of chemicals was not so common protected nature. They were small and medium-sized farms, which today are regularly demolished by global economy.

At our farm we grow spelt, rye, wheat, cereal blends, legume plants, potatoes, maize, vegetables, and we are raising beef cattle - about 65 animals.

Basic fertilizers are compost, manure and complementary fertilizers as dolomite lime, basalt etc. The average cereals yield is within 3-4 tons / ha. Only biological measures are used to protect the crops.
